## Changes Made @ The August 2012 TFAA Board Meeting

1. SYWAT has a \$60 maximum for families... Already in place.
2. A Certificate for SYWAT winners will be given at archery shops.
3. You have to shoot a minimum of 3 shoots to receive a SYWAT Plaque at State. Plaques will be for 3-4 wins, 5-6 wins and 7+ wins.
4. There will no longer be 2nd or 3rd place Aggregate Awards. The overall winner will be the best 3 SYWAT Aggregate Scores and 2 state scores for Shadow Box only.
5. There will be a Shadow Box awarded if there is only 1 shooter representing a class instead of having to have 3 shooters. You will have to have 3 SYWAT shoots and shoot both days of the State Shoot to receive the Shadow Box.
6. At all State Level Shoots the Unit System will be done away with. If you only have 3 shooters, all 3 places will be awarded.

Example – 1 Shooter, 1st Place Awarded

2 Shooters, 1st & 2nd Places will be Awarded

3 Shooters, 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places will be Awarded

### \*Reminder of Age Rule!

NFAA Rule Book, Article III Divisions of Competition, Page 35

1.4 Archer's date of birth must appear on his/her official membership card. Any Junior archer who has a birthday during a tournament will be allowed to complete that tournament in the age group he/she started in.
