From District 5

TFAA Shoot Your Way Across Texas ("SYWAT"), Indoor Season is off to a great start. As of mid-November, there have been 880 SYWAT rounds, with 680 of those taking place in District 5. In October at the first ever SYWAT tournament at Arjun Archery we had 110 archers. Thereafter, at Fort Grard we had 123 archers. In October at Cinnamon Creek Ranch, we had 213 archers, which was topped by the second SYWAT at Cinnamon Creek Ranch where we had 234 archers. It is fun to see archery growing in these events.

Remember, archers 17 and younger will receive a 300-pin in recognition of their first 300 round. I have had the pleasure of handing out two 300-pins this season and hope to hand out many more. If you, or someone you know has scored a first time 300 round, please let me know so I can hand you a 300-pin.

There are more than twenty SYWATs scheduled in District 5 and we recently added a second SYWAT at Arjun Archery. I believe the more SYWATs the better, giving archers more options to participate; hence any shops in District 5 that wish to add SYWATs are hereby encouraged to contact me, and more dates will be added to the schedule.

From the Bowhunting Director

After harvesting your deer and locating it. The next procedure would be proper field dressing your deer. Field dressing a deer is the process of removing the internal organs soon after harvest to preserve the quality of the meat and prevent spoilage. The procedure requires careful attention to cleanliness, safety, and proper technique. Safety considerations are: Always cut away from your body. Keep your knife sharp to maintain control. Wear gloves to reduce the risk of disease transmission.

Avoid cutting into the stomach or intestines, as this can contaminate the meat. Roll the deer onto its side remove internal organs and drain blood and fluids. Wipe out the cavity with clean cloth or snow if available. Inspect for any signs of disease or abnormal tissue before transporting.

Cool the Carcass by propping the body cavity open with a stick or branch to allow air circulation. Cooling should begin immediately to preserve meat quality. If the temperature is warm, pack the cavity with ice or transport the deer to a cooler as soon as possible. Inspect the liver and lungs for unusual discoloration or spots, which may indicate disease.

Field dressing a deer efficiently ensures high-quality meat and reduces spoilage risk. With practice, the process becomes faster and cleaner, setting the stage for successful butchering and processing later.

Attention Parents of Youth Archers

Please note that NFAA/TFAA rules state that an archer moves up to a higher age division on their birthday. This means that if your child has a birthday between now and the start of our State Championship Tournament, they must compete in the higher age division for the remainder of the SYWAT season and in the state tournament. In anticipation of this, you are allowed to move your child up in age division during or at the start of the SYWAT season. Once an archer moves up in age division, they must remain in that division. 1. Open to Texas Field Archery Association members only
2. Deer must be harvested within the Continental United States, using legal archery equipment, and following Parks and Wildlife regulations.
3. Crossbows are not allowed.
4. Must be harvested during the 2025-2026 hunting season
5. No High Fence or pen raised and released deer will be allowed.
6. A buck may be entered in one category only.
7. There is no entry fee to submit an entry.

Submission Requirements:

1. All entries must be submitted by January 31, 2026, to Jerry Beavin, TFAA Bowhunting Director, jerrybeavin@gmail.com. (361) 362-5263.
2. Submittal shall include:
 - a. A Boone and Crockett Scoring Sheet (Typical or Non-Typical as needed)
Scoring Sheets at boone-crockett.org
 - b. Three clear photos of the animal and hunter (One showing front profile and one showing each side profile.)
 - c. Photos of your Harvest must show respect to the animal
 - d. A brief description of the hunt and the location (Ranch/County)

The 2026 Indoor Sectional format for all sections will consist of the best one of two NFAA 300 blue/white rounds. Each archer may choose to shoot either one or two rounds. Only the highest score will count toward their final sectional and national ranking. If an archer chooses to compete at more than one location within his/her section, the best score from their first location will count.

Inside-out scoring of the X-ring will be used at all locations for tie-breakers. Electronic Scoring will be used at all sectional locations for live updates.

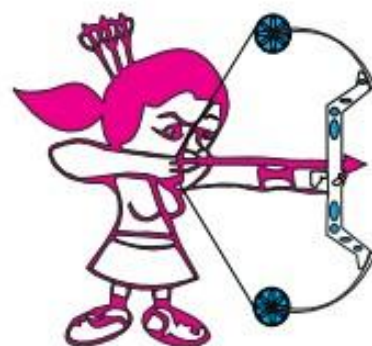

ABOUT SYWAT INDOOR

This is a statewide "league" held primarily during the winter (November - February). Tournaments are hosted by various shops or clubs around the state. Any archer can compete in the events, but you must be a NFAA/TFAA Member to compete for the SYWAT Aggregate/Tour Champion award. NFAA divisions and shooting styles will be in effect. For the current shooting styles, [CLICK HERE](#).

Costs Per Round:

- \$25 - Adult Categories
- \$20 - Cub/Youth/Young Adult
- \$70 - Max. Per Family

The indoor SYWAT format is the NFAA standard "300 Round," shot at 10 yards for cubs and 20 yards for all other age classes. Archers shoot 12 ends of 5 arrows each for a total of 60 arrows.

Targets are rotated between top and bottom after the 6th end.

Targets are the archer's choice of the NFAA 40 cm (blue) single spot, or the NFAA 5 spot.

Scoring on the 40 cm target is 5-4-3-2-1. Xs score 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

The 5-spot target is scored 5-4. Xs score as 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

SYWAT INDOOR - AGGREGATE/ HIGHEST SCORE AWARD

This goes to the top scoring shooter in their respective division and style for the SYWAT Indoor Season. Three SYWAT shoots and the State Tournament are required to be eligible for the SYWAT Tour/Aggregate Award. Your top three SYWAT scores plus your total TFAA State Indoor Championship score will be added together to determine the SYWAT Aggregate/Highest Score Award for each division and style. You can only win for one division and style. The Aggregate/Highest Score Award will be presented at the awards ceremony during the TFAA State Indoor Championship.

SYWAT INDOOR - INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Each individual SYWAT event is its own tournament. Winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be recorded for individual award purposes. Individual awards will be created and made available for pick-up at the TFAA State Indoor Championship. The individual award is a single award listing the location and place for each individual event, where the individual placed. You must place first, second, or third in three (3) or more separate events to receive a plaque. The last weekend before the State Tournament is not included in order to get awards ready in time for the tournament.



A Note About Line Etiquette

When at an archery tournament, there are a few important rules of etiquette. The rules of etiquette are based on safety, courtesy, and good sportsmanship. Below is a list of some of the most important points:

1. Be ready when your line is called, then *walk* to the shooting line.
2. Know and obey all range commands.
3. Never nock, draw, or release an arrow when someone is downrange.
4. Be careful not to bump the archers in front or behind you while approaching/leaving the line, or while shooting.
5. Make sure all of your equipment fits in your lane and does not interfere with the archers on either side of you.
6. Never talk to another archer, or to yourself while on the shooting line.
7. Never talk to anyone behind the line while you are on the shooting line.
8. If the archer on either side of you is going to full draw, or at full draw, wait quietly in place until they have shot before leaving the line.
9. Leave the line quietly and carefully.
10. After leaving the line, move away from the shooting line, rack your bow and wait far enough behind the shooting line so you won't disturb those still shooting.
11. If an archer near you is the last person still shooting, quietly remain on the line with them for support. This is a polite and appreciated gesture.
