Happy New Year and Welcome to 2026! I hope your Holiday Season was enjoyable, with lots of time with family and friends.

The last two months of our SYWAT season are ahead and there are plenty of opportunities to get your SYWAT standings toned up for the state championship. Overall, we have 41 SYWAT locations on the schedule for January and February, with 93 tournament days between them. Most locations have at least two line times per day, so you have nearly 200 opportunities to shoot! We look forward to seeing you at the range.

Two tournament dates are worth special mention.

January 17-18 are the dates for NFAA Southern Sectionals. This is a five-state championship, with five locations in Texas, plus locations in Louisiana and Oklahoma. Sign up through NFAA at <https://nfaausa.com/events/find-an-event>. This year you will have a chance to shoot once or twice.... only your best score will count toward the Sectional Championship. Your best score will also count as a SYWAT score, and your score will be entered in NFAA's national sectional ranking.

February 27-March 1, the TFAA State Championship will be held at Cinnamon Creek Ranch, in Roanoke, Texas. As always, this is a two-day tournament and you must shoot both days to be eligible for awards. Registration will be active on the TFAA website, starting January 26. More information is available in this issue of the TFAN.

There are tournaments scheduled for each weekend in January and February, including NFAA Southern Sectionals on the weekend of January 17 and TFAA State scheduled the weekend of February 28, with both events taking place at Cinnamon Creek Ranch.

Remember, archers 17 and younger will receive a 300-pin in recognition of their first 300 round. I have had the pleasure of handing out three 300-pins this season and hope to hand a lot more. If you or someone you know has shot a first time 300 round, please me know so I can hand you a 300-pin.

Attention Parents of Youth Archers

Please note that NFAA/TFAA rules state that an archer moves up to a higher age division on their birthday. This means that if your child has a birthday between now and the start of our State Championship Tournament, they must compete in the higher age division for the remainder of the SYWAT season and in the state tournament. In anticipation of this, you are allowed to move your child up in age division during or at the start of the SYWAT season. Once an archer moves up in age division, they must remain in that division. 1. Open to Texas Field Archery Association members only
2. Deer must be harvested within the Continental United States, using legal archery equipment, and following Parks and Wildlife regulations.
3. Crossbows are not allowed.
4. Must be harvested during the 2025-2026 hunting season
5. No High Fence or pen raised and released deer will be allowed.
6. A buck may be entered in one category only.
7. There is no entry fee to submit an entry.

Submission Requirements:

1. All entries must be submitted by January 31, 2026, to Jerry Beavin, TFAA Bowhunting Director, jerrybeavin@gmail.com. (361) 362-5263.
2. Submittal shall include:
 - a. A Boone and Crockett Scoring Sheet (Typical or Non-Typical as needed)
Scoring Sheets at boone-crockett.org
 - b. Three clear photos of the animal and hunter (One showing front profile and one showing each side profile.)
 - c. Photos of your Harvest must show respect to the animal
 - d. A brief description of the hunt and the location (Ranch/County)

The 2026 Indoor Sectional format for all sections will consist of the best one of two NFAA 300 blue/white rounds. Each archer may choose to shoot either one or two rounds. Only the highest score will count toward their final sectional and national ranking. If an archer chooses to compete at more than one location within his/her section, the best score from their first location will count.

Inside-out scoring of the X-ring will be used at all locations for tie-breakers. Electronic Scoring will be used at all sectional locations for live updates.

- SYWAT Plaques will be available in the Event Center Pavilion. If you know of someone not attending, please pick up their plaque and deliver it to them.

Registration Information

This is a Two Day Tournament (The Registration Fee Covers Both Days)

You must shoot both days to be eligible for awards.

Registration Options:

Friday/Saturday Line - This line will shoot at 6:30 pm both days (No changes) [You will not shoot on Sunday]. Note: If you shoot Friday/Saturday, your class awards will be on Sunday.

Saturday Lines (7:30 am, 11:15 am, or 3:00 pm) - You may choose one of these times for your Saturday shoot time (space available). (Cubs will have the option of 11:15 am or 3:00 pm)

Sunday Line Times - Those shooting the Saturday Lines will be **ASSIGNED their Sunday line time**. This is done in order to get all of a division/styles together for award purposes.

We schedule the youth classes early so archers may travel back home for school Monday

Cubs will shoot at either 7:30 am or 11:15 am (classes to be determined)

All Youth will shoot at 7:30 am

All Young Adults will shoot at 11:15 am

Adult classes will be distributed as required to balance the lines

There will be an awards ceremony following each Sunday line If you shoot Friday/Saturday, your class awards will be on Sunday.

Sunday Line Times by Individual will be posted on the TFAA website by the Thursday before the tournament.

The registration system will select your age division based on your birthdate. If you intend to shoot in an age division other than your normal age class, you will need to contact info@texasfieldarchery.org or call Mark Tanner at 214-770-5903. 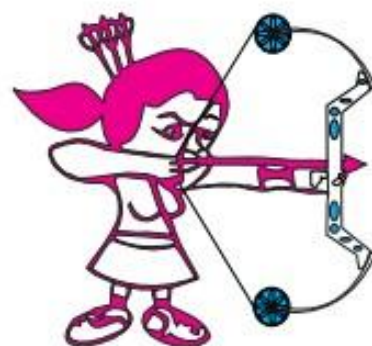

Request for Donations to the TFAA Scholarship Fund

Since 2018, TFAA has awarded scholarships to deserving young men and women who have demonstrated academic, community and archery success. Currently, each year TFAA awards one scholarship to a high school senior in the amount of \$5,000. The deadline to apply is January 31, 2026, with the winner to be announced at TFAA State Indoor Championships, the weekend of February 28.

TFAA, a non-profit corporation holds approximately \$36,000 in the TFAA Scholarship Fund, and our goal is to increase the fund so that in the future we can award a larger amount to the winner and possibly award additional scholarships. ABOUT SYWAT INDOOR

This is a statewide "league" held primarily during the winter (November - February). Tournaments are hosted by various shops or clubs around the state. Any archer can compete in the events, but you must be a NFAA/TFAA Member to compete for the SYWAT Aggregate/Tour Champion award. NFAA divisions and shooting styles will be in effect. For the current shooting styles, [CLICK HERE](#).

Costs Per Round:

- \$25 - Adult Categories
- \$20 - Cub/Youth/Young Adult
- \$70 - Max. Per Family

The indoor SYWAT format is the NFAA standard "300 Round," shot at 10 yards for cubs and 20 yards for all other age classes. Archers shoot 12 ends of 5 arrows each for a total of 60 arrows.

Targets are rotated between top and bottom after the 6th end.

Targets are the archer's choice of the NFAA 40 cm (blue) single spot, or the NFAA 5 spot.

Scoring on the 40 cm target is 5-4-3-2-1. Xs score 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

The 5-spot target is scored 5-4. Xs score as 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

SYWAT INDOOR - AGGREGATE/ HIGHEST SCORE AWARD

This goes to the top scoring shooter in their respective division and style for the SYWAT Indoor Season. Three SYWAT shoots and the State Tournament are required to be eligible for the SYWAT Tour/Aggregate Award. Your top three SYWAT scores plus your total TFAA State Indoor Championship score will be added together to determine the SYWAT Aggregate/Highest Score Award for each division and style. You can only win for one division and style. The Aggregate/Highest Score Award will be presented at the awards ceremony during the TFAA State Indoor Championship.

SYWAT INDOOR - INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Each individual SYWAT event is its own tournament. Winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be recorded for individual award purposes. Individual awards will be created and made available for pick-up at the TFAA State Indoor Championship. The individual award is a single award listing the location and place for each individual event, where the individual placed. You must place first, second, or third in three (3) or more separate events to receive a plaque. The last weekend before the State Tournament is not included in order to get awards ready in time for the tournament.



A Note About Line Etiquette

When at an archery tournament, there are a few important rules of etiquette. The rules of etiquette are based on safety, courtesy, and good sportsmanship. Below is a list of some of the most important points:

1. Be ready when your line is called, then *walk* to the shooting line.
2. Know and obey all range commands.
3. Never nock, draw, or release an arrow when someone is downrange.
4. Be careful not to bump the archers in front or behind you while approaching/leaving the line, or while shooting.
5. Make sure all of your equipment fits in your lane and does not interfere with the archers on either side of you.
6. Never talk to another archer, or to yourself while on the shooting line.
7. Never talk to anyone behind the line while you are on the shooting line.
8. If the archer on either side of you is going to full draw, or at full draw, wait quietly in place until they have shot before leaving the line.
9. Leave the line quietly and carefully.
10. After leaving the line, move away from the shooting line, rack your bow and wait far enough behind the shooting line so you won't disturb those still shooting.
11. If an archer near you is the last person still shooting, quietly remain on the line with them for support. This is a polite and appreciated gesture.
