Formats:

900 American Round - 5 Ends of 6 arrows = 30 arrows at each at Long, Medium , and Short distances as per chart below by age group

Known 3D - 2 arrows per 28 targets at known distance (Range finder), with maximum distances in chart below. Scoring is 10pts- Larger Inner Circle, 8pts- Outer Circle/Kill Zone, 5pts- Body.

There is no 11 or 12 ring scoring.

About the TFAA 900 & Known 3D

The TFAA 900 Shoot is an American round consisting of 5 Ends of 6 arrows = 30 arrows each at Long, Middle, and Short yardages as shown below. The target for all distances is the standard 122cm FITA target face with scoring rings from 10 to 1. X's will count as tie breaker. Each End has a 5 Minute Time limit.

900 Age Group	Distance 1	Distance 2	Distance 3
Cub (11 and under)	30 Yards	20 Yards	10 Yards
Youth (12-14)	50 Yards	40 Yards	30 Yards
Adult/Young Adult (15 and older)	60 Yards	50 Yards	40 Yards

The TFAA Known 3D Shoot is a 28 target $\underline{2}$ arrows per target, 10-8-5 scoring, at a known distance (Via your Range Finder). Maximum distances for any target are shown in the Age Group chart below.

3D Age Group	Maximum Distance	Stake Color
Cub (11 and under)	25 Yards	Blue
Traditional & Long Bow (18 and older)	25 Yards	Blue
Youth (12–14)	40 Yards	Yellow
Master Senior (70+)	40 Yards	Yellow
Young Adult, Adult, Senior, Silver Senior (15-69)	50 Yards	White
