

Indoor Season is off to a fantastic start in District 5. The TFAA Shoot Your Way Across Texas ("SWYAT") indoor season started on November 1 at Cinnamon Creek Ranch, with shoots in the following weeks at Fort Grard Guns & Archery, APOS Ranch & Outdoors, AISD Archery Training and Alvarado Archery. 677 archers shot arrows in the first five SYWATS.

If you have not participated before, please come and join us. Indoor season competition requires archers to shoot 60 arrows at a 40 cm target. Cubs (ages 8-11) shoot from 10 yards, and all others shoot from 20 years. Indoor SYWATs are fun and are a great introduction for beginner archers. SYWATs are friendly but do offer stiff competition for more advanced shooters preparing for the season ending TFAA State Indoor Championship next February. Attention Parents of Youth Shooters

Please note NFAA/TFAA rules state that an archer moves up to a higher age division on their birthday. This means that if your child will have a birthday between now and the start of our State Championship, they must shoot in the higher age division for the remainder of the SYWAT season and in the state shoot. In anticipation of this, you are allowed to move your child up in age division during or at the start of the SYWAT season. Once a shooter moves up in age division, they must remain in that division. Please see your Field Governor at one of the SYWAT shoots if you have questions or email info@texasfieldarchery.org.

Request for Donations to the TFAA Scholarship Fund

Commencing 2018, TFAA has awarded scholarships to deserving young men and women who have demonstrated academic, community and athletic success. Currently, each year TFAA awards one scholarship to a high school senior in the amount of \$5,000. TFAA holds approximately \$29,000 in the TFAA Scholarship Fund, the short-term goal is to increase the fund to \$100,000 and operate as endowment, disbursing 5% annually. In the next few years, it is the goal to increase the endowment fund to \$1,000,000 so that scholarships in the cumulative amount of \$50,000 could be awarded to deserving TFAA high school seniors. It will be fun to potentially increase the number of scholarships, and/or the amount of each scholarship awarded. TFAA By-Laws Addition

The TFAA Board of Directors met recently and adopted the following to the TFAA By-Laws:

No Dogs at TFAA State Events: With the exception of Service Animals as described herein, No dogs, or other animals are allowed at TFAA State Events.

Service Animals: Service animals are defined as dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Examples of such work or tasks include guiding who are blind, alerting people who are deaf, pulling a wheelchair, or alerting and protecting a person who is having a seizure, reminding a person with mental illness to take prescribed medications, calming a person with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) during an anxiety attack, or performing other duties. Service animals are working animals, not pets. The work or task a dog has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability. Dogs or other service animals whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Note: Per TFAA Policy, Emotional Support Animals, which differ from Service Animals, do not enjoy the same legal status as service animals per the ADA, and are not allowed on the field of play.

Where Service Animals Are Allowed: Per the ADA, State and local governments, businesses, and nonprofit organizations that serve the public generally must allow service animals to accompany people with disabilities in all areas of the facility where the public is normally allowed to go. At TFAA Archery events, service animals are allowed in the archers' area, which is defined as any place the archer is allowed. Archers needing accommodation outside of these guidelines are to be managed on a case by case basis.

Service Animals Must Be Under Control: Per the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices. In that case, the individual must maintain control of the animal through voice, signal, or other effective controls.

Service animals should always demonstrate the following behaviors:

- Be focused on their handler
- Have a stable, even temperament
- Remain quietly by their handler's side
- Ignore distractions
- Present professional
- Keep their nose to themselves
- Respond promptly to handler's cues and directions

Inquiries, Exclusions, Charges and Other Specific Rules Related to Service Animals: When it is not obvious what service an animal provides, only limited inquiries are allowed. Staff may ask two questions: (1) is the dog a service animal required because of a disability, and (2) what work, or task has the dog been trained to perform. Staff cannot ask about the person's disability, require medical documentation, require a special identification card or training documentation for the dog, or ask that the dog demonstrate its ability to perform the work or task.

Note: This policy is based on the USA Archery policy updated December 2023.

General Rules:

- 1. Open to Texas Field Archery Association members only
- 2. Deer must be harvested within the Continental United States, using legal archery equipment, and following Parks and Wildlife regulations.
- 3. Crossbows are not allowed.
- 4. Must be harvested during the 2024-2025 hunting season.
- 5. No High Fence or pen raised and released deer will be allowed.
- 6. A buck may be entered in one category only.
- 7. There is no entry fee to submit an entry.

Submission Requirements:

- 1. All entries must be submitted by January 31, 2025, to Jerry Beavin, TFAA Bowhunting Director, <u>jerrybeavin@gmail.com</u>. (361) 362-5263.
- 2. Submittal shall include:
 - a. A Boone and Crocket Scoring Sheet (Typical or Non-Typical as needed)
 - b. Three clear photos of the animal and hunter (One showing front profile and one showing each side profile.)
 - c. Photos of your Harvest must show respect to the animal.
 - d. A brief description of the hunt and the location (Ranch/County)

ABOUT SYWAT INDOOR

This is a statewide "league" held primarily during the winter (November - February). Tournaments are hosted by various shops or clubs around the state. Any archer can compete in the events, but you must be a NFAA/TFAA Member to compete for the SYWAT Aggregate/Tour Champion award. N.F.A.A. divisions and shooting styles will be in effect. For the current shooting styles, **CLICK HERE.**

Costs Per Round:

\$25 - Adult Categories

\$20 - Cub/Youth/Young Adult

\$70 - Max. Per Family

The indoor SYWAT format is the NFAA standard "300 Round," shot at 10 yards for cubs and 20 yards for all other age classes. Archers shoot 12 ends of 5 arrows each for a total of 60 arrows.

Targets are rotated between top and bottom after the 6th end.

Targets are the archer's choice of the NFAA 40 cm (blue) single spot, or the NFAA 5 spot.

Scoring on the 40 cm target is 5-4-3-2-1. Xs score 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

The 5-spot target is scored 5-4. Xs score as 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

SYWAT INDOOR - AGGREGATE/ HIGHEST SCORE AWARD

This goes to the top scoring shooter in their respective division and style for the SYWAT Indoor Season. Three SYWAT shoots and the State Tournament are required to be eligible for the SYWAT Tour/Aggregate Award. Your top three SYWAT scores plus your total TFAA State Indoor Championship score will be added together to determine the SYWAT Aggregate/Highest Score Award for each division and style. You can only win for one division and style. The Aggregate/Highest Score Award award will be presented at the awards ceremony during the TFAA State Indoor Championship.

SYWAT INDOOR - INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Each individual SYWAT event is its own tournament. Winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be recorded for individual award purposes. Individual awards will be created and made available for pick-up at the TFAA State Indoor Championship. The individual award is a single award listing the location and place for each individual event, where the individual placed. You must place first, second, or third in three (3) or more separate events to receive a plaque. The last weekend before the State Tournament is not included in order to get awards ready in time for the tournament.



A Note About Line Etiquette

It's great to see the growth and influx of new archers. Many are shooting competitions for the first time. Shops and coaches are doing a great job of teaching archery, but let's not forget line etiquette. This will make the competition experience a lot better for the new shooters, other archers on the line, and officials running the shoot.

- 1. Be ready when your line is called, then walk, don't run, to the shooting line.
- 2. Be careful not to bump the shooters in front or behind you while approaching/leaving the line, or while shooting.
- 3. Never talk to another shooter, or to yourself while on the shooting line.
- 4. Never talk to anyone behind the line while you are on the shooting line.
- 5. If the shooter on either side of you is going to full draw, or at full draw, wait quietly in place until they have shot before leaving the line.
- 6. Leave the line quietly.
- 7. After leaving the line, move away from the shooting line, rack your bow and wait far enough behind the shooting line so you won't disturb those still shooting.
- 8. If a shooter near you is the last person still shooting, quietly remain on the line with them for support. This is a polite and appreciated gesture.


