# From the Bowhunting Director

After harvesting a deer with a bow and arrow, the steps you take immediately afterward are critical for ensuring an ethical harvest, recovering the animal efficiently, and preserving the quality of the meat.

Immediate Actions After the Shot. Stay Quiet and Still.

After releasing your arrow, remain in your shooting position for at least 30 minutes (or longer if unsure of the shot placement). Sudden movement or noise can cause a wounded deer to run farther. Observe the deer's reaction. Watch carefully where the arrow hits and how the deer reacts.

- Heart/lung shot: The deer typically runs 50–100 yards before collapsing.
- *Gut shot:* The deer may hunch up and walk away slowly—wait several hours before tracking.
- Spine or shoulder hit: The deer may drop immediately but require a follow-up shot.

Assessing the Shot and Waiting Period. Mark the spot.

Mentally or physically mark the exact location where the deer was standing when you shot and where you last saw it. Use landmarks like trees or rocks. Wait before tracking.

- Heart/lung hit: Wait 30-60 minutes.
- Liver hit: Wait 3-4 hours.
- Gut hit: Wait 6-8 hours or overnight if possible.

Waiting ensures the deer lies down and expires without being pushed farther.

Tracking and Recovery. Inspect the arrow and blood trail. Retrieve your arrow (if possible) and examine it:


- Bright red, frothy blood = Lung shot.
- Dark red = Liver hit
- Green or foul-smelling = Gut shot.

Follow the blood trail carefully. Move slowly, scanning for blood on leaves, ground, or vegetation. Mark each spot with flagging tape or biodegradable markers. If the trail fades, circle outward slowly to relocate it. Approach with caution. When you find the deer, approach from behind and watch for any signs of movement. If the animal is still alive, use a follow-up shot to ensure a quick, humane death.

### General Rules:

- 1. Open to Texas Field Archery Association members only
- Deer must be harvested within the Continental United States, using legal archery equipment, and following Parks and Wildlife regulations.
- 3. Crossbows are not allowed.
- 4. Must be harvested during the 2025-2026 hunting season
- No High Fence or pen raised and released deer will be allowed.
- A buck may be entered in one category only.
- There is no entry fee to submit an entry.

## Submission Requirements:

- All entries must be submitted by January 31, 2026, to Jerry Beavin, TFAA Bowhunting Director, <u>ierrybeavin@gmail.com</u>. (361) 362-5263.
- 2. Submittal shall include:
  - A Boone and Crocket Scoring Sheet (Typical or Non-Typical as needed)
     Scoring Sheets at <u>boone-crockett.org</u>
  - Three clear photos of the animal and hunter (One showing front profile and one showing each side profile.)
  - c. Photos of your Harvest must show respect to the animal
  - d. A brief description of the hunt and the location (Ranch/County)



# 2026 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The 2026 Indoor Sectional format for all sections will consist of the best one of two NFAA 300 blue/white rounds. Each archer may choose to shoot either one or two rounds. Only the highest score will count toward their final sectional and national ranking. If an archer chooses to compete at more than one location within his/her section, the best score from their first location will count.

Inside-out scoring of the X-ring will be used at all locations for tie-breakers. Electronic Scoring will be used at all sectional locations for live updates.

# **ABOUT SYWAT INDOOR**

This is a statewide "league" held primarily during the winter (November - February). Tournaments are hosted by various shops or clubs around the state. Any archer can compete in the events, but you must be a NFAA/TFAA Member to compete for the SYWAT Aggregate/Tour Champion award. NFAA divisions and shooting styles will be in effect. For the current shooting styles, **CLICK HERE.** 

### Costs Per Round:

\$25 - Adult Categories

\$20 - Cub/Youth/Young Adult

\$70 - Max. Per Family

The indoor SYWAT format is the NFAA standard "300 Round," shot at 10 yards for cubs and 20 yards for all other age classes. Archers shoot 12 ends of 5 arrows each for a total of 60 arrows.

Targets are rotated between top and bottom after the 6th end.

Targets are the archer's choice of the NFAA 40 cm (blue) single spot, or the NFAA 5 spot.

Scoring on the 40 cm target is 5-4-3-2-1. Xs score 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

The 5-spot target is scored 5-4. Xs score as 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

# **SYWAT INDOOR - AGGREGATE/ HIGHEST SCORE AWARD**

This goes to the top scoring shooter in their respective division and style for the SYWAT Indoor Season. Three SYWAT shoots and the State Tournament are required to be eligible for the SYWAT Tour/Aggregate Award. Your top three SYWAT scores plus your total TFAA State Indoor Championship score will be added together to determine the SYWAT Aggregate/Highest Score Award for each division and style. You can only win for one division and style. The Aggregate/Highest Score Award will be presented at the awards ceremony during the TFAA State Indoor Championship.

# **SYWAT INDOOR - INDIVIDUAL AWARDS**

Each individual SYWAT event is its own tournament. Winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be recorded for individual award purposes. Individual awards will be created and made available for pick-up at the TFAA State Indoor Championship. The individual award is a single award listing the location and place for each individual event, where the individual placed. You must place first, second, or third in three (3) or more separate events to receive a plaque. The last weekend before the State Tournament is not included in order to get awards ready in time for the tournament.



# **A Note About Line Etiquette**

When at an archery tournament, there are a few important rules of etiquette. The rules of etiquette are based on safety, courtesy, and good sportsmanship. Below is a list of some of the most important points:

- 1. Be ready when your line is called, then *walk* to the shooting line.
- 2. Know and obey all range commands.
- 3. Never nock, draw, or release an arrow when someone is downrange.
- 4. Be careful not to bump the archers in front or behind you while approaching/leaving the line, or while shooting.
- 5. Make sure all of your equipment fits in your lane and does not interfere with the archers on either side of you.
- 6. Never talk to another archer, or to yourself while on the shooting line.
- 7. Never talk to anyone behind the line while you are on the shooting line.
- 8. If the archer on either side of you is going to full draw, or at full draw, wait quietly in place until they have shot before leaving the line.
- 9. Leave the line quietly and carefully.
- 10. After leaving the line, move away from the shooting line, rack your bow and wait far enough behind the shooting line so you won't disturb those still shooting.
- 11. If an archer near you is the last person still shooting, quietly remain on the line with them for support. This is a polite and appreciated gesture.


