From the President

TFAA was well represented in Yankton, SD for the NFAA National Roundup in late September.

Ten TFAA archers participated in the Dakota Classic, with seven of these making the final podium..... all in the youth divisions. Thanks to all who participated and special recognition to Elise Schleifer, Addison Schleifer, Zayden Boone, Ella Phillips, Aditi Yadagiri, Mason Travelstead, and Kenya Boone, our youth competitors who represented Texas so well.

We also had thirteen participants in the NFAA National Target Championship, with twelve of the thirteen making the podium. Our Youth shooters again did well, including Addison, Elise, Ella, Zayden, and Kenya from above, plus Drew Parker and Kelton Poindexter. Extra special recognition to Drew and Ella for setting new national records in their categories.

The most exciting news is that the SYWAT season starts later this month, with tournaments starting the weekend of October 25. We have 65+ tournaments on the schedule and with most shops holding four or more line times, there are more than 250 opportunities to shoot an indoor SYWAT this season.

NFAA is adding a new Modern Bowhunter Freestyle shooting style, effective January 1, for NFAA events. The TFAA Board of Directors voted to recognize this new style effective with the start of the SYWAT season. More details are below in this edition of the TFAN.

Due to cost increases, the TFAA Board of Directors recently voted to increase TFAA dues by \$5/year. This change goes into effect January 1. More details are below in this edition of the TFAN.

The Board also elected to keep all other prices the same. SYWAT remains \$25 for adults and \$20 for youth and state tournaments will remain \$50 for adults and \$35 for youth. These events are a great value, and we are committed to giving you the most value we can for your time and money.

Tune up those indoor arrows and join us. We look forward to seeing you!

NEW NFAA RECOGNIZED SHOOTING STYLE

Modern Bowhunter Freestyle (MBH)

1. Any sight and scope may be used as long as the scope itself does not contain a glass lens. Scopes with lenses, clickers and draw checks are not allowed. A sight pin consisting of a housing with a hole through it that does not contain a fixed reference point within the hole, is not allowed.
2. Release aids will be permitted. In the case of physical disability of the arms or hands, a chew strap may be used in place of fingers or release aids.
3. A pinguard mounted on the sight, and a level mounted anywhere will be legal in this style of shooting.
4. A string of suitable material with a center serving and end servings of the same or different color than the string is allowed.
5. One consistent nocking point only is permitted. Nocking point locators shall not extend more than ½ inch above or below the arrow nock when at full draw.
6. Brush buttons and string silencers properly attached are legal.
7. One anchor point only is permitted.
8. All arrows shall be identical in size, length, weight, and fletching with allowances for wear and tear.
9. Straight stabilizer, coupling device included if used, which cannot exceed 18 inches at any time, as measured from the back of the bow, V-bar, counterbalance and string silencers may be used.
10. An archer will not be permitted to change the draw weight of the bow during a round.
11. This style is available to all NFAA age divisions, male and female.

From the Bowhunting Director

The archery-only season in most counties begins September 27 and runs through October 31. Texas hunters can expect a strong white-tailed deer season. According to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD), healthy deer populations, strong fawn survival rates, and an increasing number of mature bucks are contributing to this year's outlook that is expected to be average to above average across the state.

A tag from the hunting license of the person who killed the deer must be correctly and legibly completed (including name of property and county) and immediately attached to the animal and must be reported within 24 hours of harvest. Hunters in possession of a digital license and tags should refer to [Digital Licenses and Tagging](#) for tagging instructions.

The Hill Country continues to have the highest population density in the state. South Texas is known as the premier big buck destination in the state. The Cross Timbers region boasts the second-largest deer population in Texas. TPWD reminds hunters to review current regulations before heading to the field.

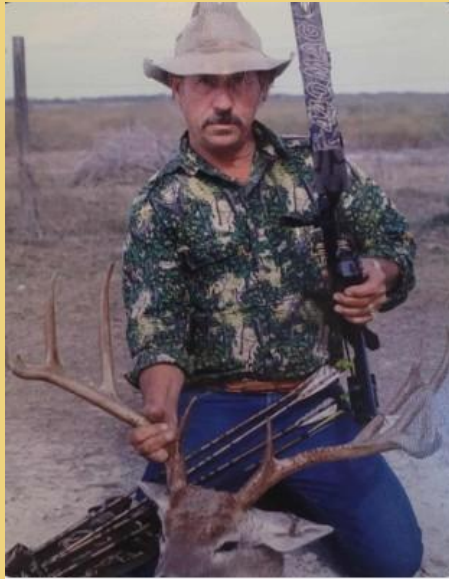

3. Crossbows are not allowed.
4. Must be harvested during the 2025-2026 hunting season
5. No High Fence or pen raised and released deer will be allowed.
6. A buck may be entered in one category only.
7. There is no entry fee to submit an entry.

Submission Requirements:

1. All entries must be submitted by January 31, 2026, to Jerry Beavin, TFAA Bowhunting Director, jerrybeavin@gmail.com. (361) 362-5263.
2. Submittal shall include:
 - a. A Boone and Crockett Scoring Sheet (Typical or Non-Typical as needed)
Scoring Sheets at boone-crockett.org
 - b. Three clear photos of the animal and hunter (One showing front profile and one showing each side profile.)
 - c. Photos of your Harvest must show respect to the animal
 - d. A brief description of the hunt and the location (Ranch/County)

ABOUT SYWAT INDOOR

This is a statewide "league" held primarily during the winter (November - February). Tournaments are hosted by various shops or clubs around the state. Any archer can compete in the events, but you must be a NFAA/TFAA Member to compete for the SYWAT Aggregate/Tour Champion award. NFAA divisions and shooting styles will be in effect. For the current shooting styles, [CLICK HERE](#).

Costs Per Round:

- \$25 - Adult Categories
- \$20 - Cub/Youth/Young Adult
- \$70 - Max. Per Family

The indoor SYWAT format is the NFAA standard "300 Round," shot at 10 yards for cubs and 20 yards for all other age classes. Archers shoot 12 ends of 5 arrows each for a total of 60 arrows.

Targets are rotated between top and bottom after the 6th end.

Targets are the archer's choice of the NFAA 40 cm (blue) single spot, or the NFAA 5 spot.

Scoring on the 40 cm target is 5-4-3-2-1. Xs score 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

The 5-spot target is scored 5-4. Xs score as 5 and are counted as a tiebreaker.

SYWAT INDOOR - AGGREGATE/ HIGHEST SCORE AWARD

This goes to the top scoring shooter in their respective division and style for the SYWAT Indoor Season. Three SYWAT shoots and the State Tournament are required to be eligible for the SYWAT Tour/Aggregate Award. Your top three SYWAT scores plus your total TFAA State Indoor Championship score will be added together to determine the SYWAT Aggregate/Highest Score Award for each division and style. You can only win for one division and style. The Aggregate/Highest Score Award will be presented at the awards ceremony during the TFAA State Indoor Championship.

SYWAT INDOOR - INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Each individual SYWAT event is its own tournament. Winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be recorded for individual award purposes. Individual awards will be created and made available for pick-up at the TFAA State Indoor Championship. The individual award is a single award listing the location and place for each individual event, where the individual placed. You must place first, second, or third in three (3) or more separate events to receive a plaque. The last weekend before the State Tournament is not included in order to get awards ready in time for the tournament.



A Note About Line Etiquette

When at an archery tournament, there are a few important rules of etiquette. The rules of etiquette are based on safety, courtesy, and good sportsmanship. Below is a list of some of the most important points:

1. Be ready when your line is called, then *walk* to the shooting line.
2. Know and obey all range commands.
3. Never nock, draw, or release an arrow when someone is downrange.
4. Be careful not to bump the archers in front or behind you while approaching/leaving the line, or while shooting.
5. Make sure all of your equipment fits in your lane and does not interfere with the archers on either side of you.
6. Never talk to another archer, or to yourself while on the shooting line.
7. Never talk to anyone behind the line while you are on the shooting line.
8. If the archer on either side of you is going to full draw, or at full draw, wait quietly in place until they have shot before leaving the line.
9. Leave the line quietly and carefully.
10. After leaving the line, move away from the shooting line, rack your bow and wait far enough behind the shooting line so you won't disturb those still shooting.
11. If an archer near you is the last person still shooting, quietly remain on the line with them for support. This is a polite and appreciated gesture.

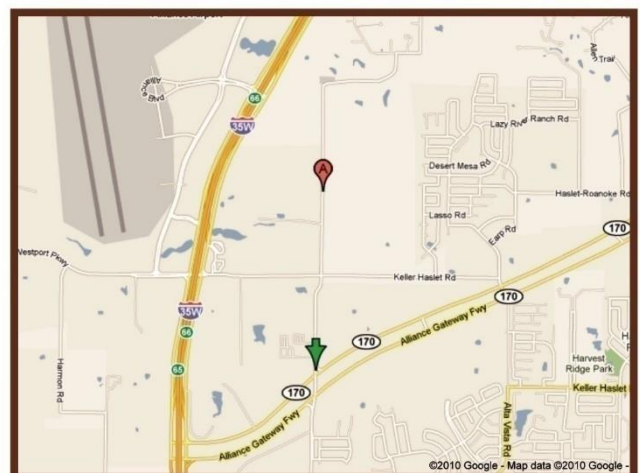

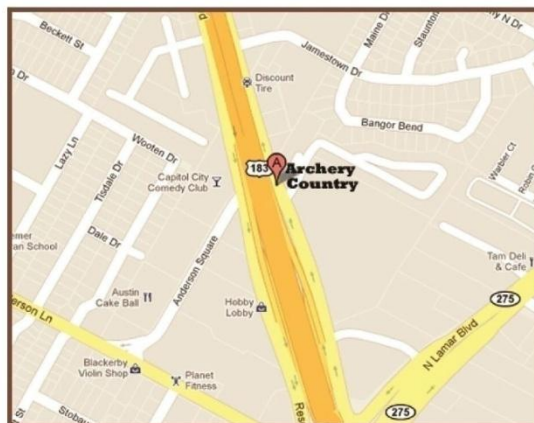
